# Letter from the Board President

It is an uncommon resource committed to teach and inspire a diverse population of all ages through demonstration gardens, classes and events. 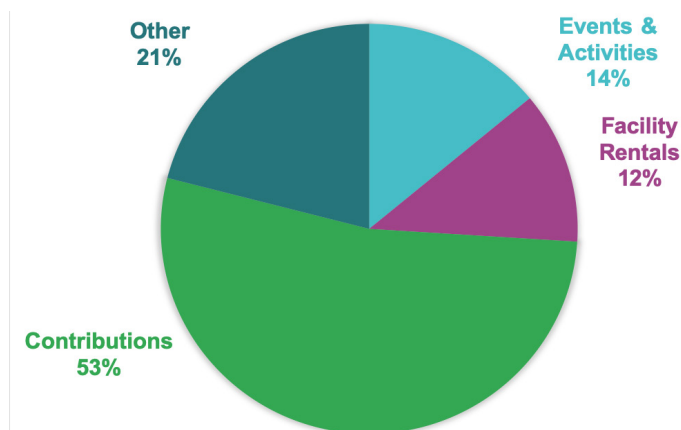

We hope you visit Gamble Garden often, enjoying the gardens, the house and the events. May this be a season full of THANKS and GIVING for you and your family.

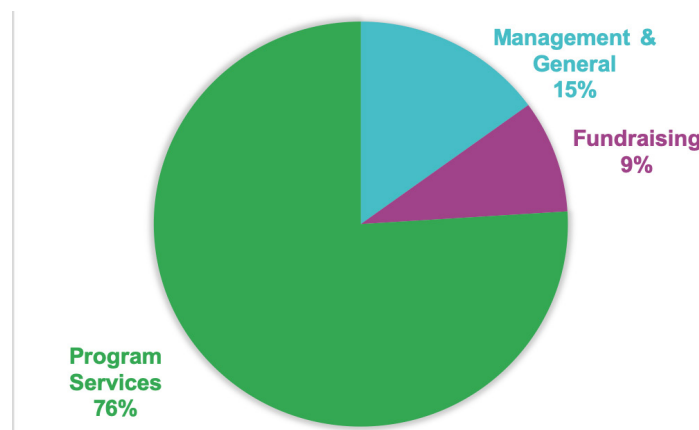

# Report on the Gamble Garden Endowment

For future generations, the Gamble Garden Endowment supports what you value about the Garden now and benefits the future in ways we cannot imagine. Finding ways to support charitable organizations we hold close to our hearts adds meaning to our lives no other experience can. The Gamble Garden Endowment ensures the long-term health, viability, and success of the Garden and its programs.

## Report on our Investments

The Gamble Garden's endowment is valued at \$ 4.2M as of June 30, 2019. A distribution of \$150,000 supported 19.3% of Gamble's expenses this year.

The Endowment Committee is delighted to report that, over its lifetime, \$1.4M has been distributed to support Gamble's programs. Money donated to the Endowment is for the future, but lends financial support each year. Gamble Garden would like to acknowledge and thank our investment advisor, Creative Planning and its Director of Institutional Services, Tiya Lim.

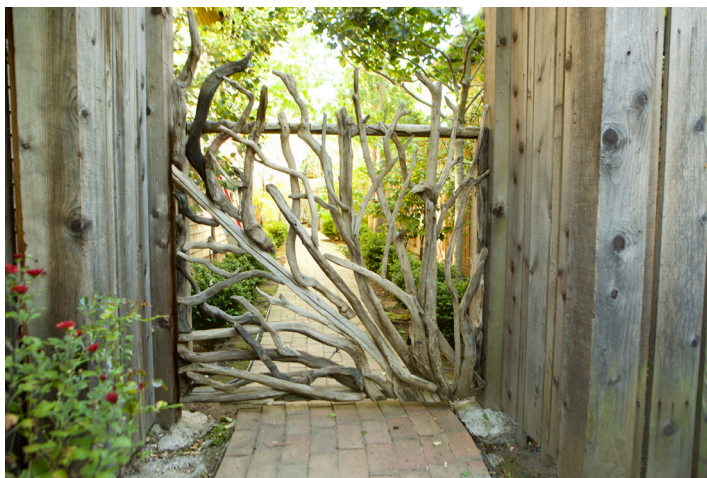

# Gamble Garden's Non-Profit Partners

At its heart, Gamble Garden is dedicated to teaching and enriching the community through knowledge and ideas around gardens and the practice of gardening. We were fortunate to partner with several non-profits in 2019.

We received grants from Garden Club of Palo Alto, Woodside-Atherton Garden Club and the Atherton Garden Guild. These funds enable special projects that may otherwise not be possible.

We collaborate with multiple non-profits helping them reach out to the public during our events, including Spring Tour and Second Saturdays. In 2019, we worked with the Wildlife Center of Silicon Valley, Grassroots Ecology, Green Waste of Palo Alto, and the Native Plant Society.

We work closely with some organizations in a deeper partnership to achieve our mission of developing learning curricula and bringing gardening directly to the classroom and to people who might not otherwise have the opportunity to learn about the impact of gardens--and the accessibility of gardening. These organizations include Canopy, The Garden Club of Palo Alto, Environmental Volunteers, the Master Gardeners of Santa Clara County, Foothill College, Downtown Streets of Palo Alto, and Walter Hays Elementary.

We were fortunate to have help from young volunteers from the following schools: Palo Alto High School, Gunn High School, Greene Middle School, Jane L. Stanford Middle School, and Castilleja School.

We coordinated efforts with these professional horticulture associations in 2019: Bay Area Garden Networks, Association of Professional Landscape Designers, Pacific Horticulture, Western Horticulture, and Marin Art and Garden Center.

Finally, our partnership with the City of Palo Alto is crucial to the existence of Gamble Garden.

We look forward to working with all these organizations in the years ahead.
