 - Growing healthy plants for healthy foods
 - Growing culturally appropriate food in your garden

In Process:

- 1. October Second Saturday is Mariposas y Muciélagos. The focus is the wonderful world of butterflies and bats in celebration of Hispanic Heritage Month. Offerings will include live bat demonstrations, presentations on monarch life cycle and migration, Mexican flower making, agua fresca refreshments, music, crafts, and family garden tours.
